



2008-2009 Activity Policies

Students: *Your participation in extracurricular activities at STRIDE Academy is dependent on your eligibility. Make sure you remain eligible by reviewing the information in this brochure with your parents/guardians. Student Code of Responsibilities:

A student who is under penalty or exclusion, expulsion or suspension, whose character or conduct violates the Student Code of Responsibilities and is not in good standing, shall be ineligible for a period of time as determined by the principal or coach.

As a student participating in extracurricular activities at STRIDE Academy, I understand and accept the following responsibilities.

- 1. I will respect the rights and beliefs of others and will treat others with courtesy and consideration.*
- 2. I will be fully responsible for my actions and the consequences.*
- 3. I will respect the property of others.*
- 4. I will respect and obey the rules of my school and the laws of my community, state and country.*
- 5. I will show respect to those who are responsible for enforcing the rules of my school and the laws of my community, state and country.*

Student Code of Responsibilities Penalties:

1. PSP's
 - a. A student receiving a PSP will not be allowed to practice on that day. A student receiving a PSP is not allowed to participate for the first half of the next in season game.
 - b. A student receiving two PSP's in one sport season will not be allowed to participate in the next in season game and will miss practice on the day of receiving the PSP.
 - c. A student receiving three or more PSP's in one sport season will miss one week of practice and games from the date of the incident.
 - d. A student receiving four or more PSP's in season will be dismissed from the team.
2. A student receiving a detention will miss one week of practice and games from the date of the incident.
3. A student receiving in school or out of school suspension will miss two weeks of practices and games from the date of the incident.
4. School Administration and/or coaches can evaluate student fulfillment of the code of responsibilities. Ineligibility can be determined by both school administrators and coaches.

Eligibility Checklist:

- _____ 1. Physical exam within the last three years on file with the school. Not applicable to non-athletic activities.
- _____ 2. Have not and will not use or possess tobacco or alcoholic beverages, use, consume, have in possession, buy, sell or give away any other controlled substance.
- _____ 3. Making academic progress (to remain eligible a student cannot be failing at any point during a grading period).
- _____ 4. All fees and forms turned into Mr. Lutterman. Forms include:
 - Eligibility Statement
 - Emergency Information and Contact Form
 - School Medical Form
 - Physical Form or Physician Written Clearance
 - \$50.00 Fee

Eligibility Penalties:

1. First Violation: Student shall lose eligibility in that sport for the next two weeks. If there are fewer than two weeks remaining in that activity, the loss of eligibility will continue into the next activity.
2. Second Violation: The student will lose eligibility for the next four weeks.
3. Third Violation: The student will lose eligibility for the rest of that activity or six weeks which ever is greater.
