



EDUCATIONAL GOALS

The School agrees to the following outcomes.

Goal 1: State Assessment Tests (MCA-IIs)

Sub-Goal # 1: Math: 90% of all students enrolled at the School for three years will score at least proficient.

Sub-Goal # 2: Math: The School will demonstrate higher grade level and school wide proficiency rates than the St. Cloud school district and district school of like demographics. A comparison of NCLB sub-categories will be used to generate the data used to measure this goal.

Sub-Goal # 3: Reading: 90% of all students enrolled at the School for three years will scores at least proficient.

Sub-Goal # 4: Reading: The School will demonstrate higher grade level and school wide proficiency rates than the St. Cloud school district and district school of like demographics. A comparison of NCLB sub-categories will be used to generate the data used to measure this goal.

Sub Goal #5: 77.6% of ALL 3-6 grade students will meet the standard or exceed on the Math MCA-II test.

Sub Goal #6: 77.5% of ALL 3-6 grade students will meet or exceed on the Reading MCA-II test.

Goal 2: NWEA: Measures of Academic Progress

Sub-Goal: In FY 2008-09, 75% of continuously enrolled students for at least one full academic year will, during that year, meet or exceed their targeted RIT growth.

Sub-Goal: In FY 2009-10, 80% of continuously enrolled students for at least one full academic year will, during that year, meet or exceed their targeted RIT growth.

Sub-Goal: In FY 2010-11, 80% of continuously enrolled students for at least one full academic year will, during that year, meet or exceed their targeted RIT growth.

Goal 3: Attendance

STRIDE Academy students will show at least a 1.5 % increase in the student attendance rate from the previous school years.

Goal 4: Satisfaction Surveys

Sub-Goal #1: Parent Satisfaction: At least 85% of all parents returning the annual survey will indicate overall satisfaction with the School.

Sub-Goal #2: Staff Satisfaction: At least 85% of all staff returning the annual survey will indicate overall satisfaction at the School.
